Management of AMEE: AMEE is managed by an elected Executive Committee, consisting of President, General Secretary/Treasurer and six others, nominations for which are invited from members. A list of the current Executive Committee is on the website. AMEE holds a General Assembly each year in September, during the Conference. The agenda for the General Assembly is circulated in advance to all members, who are invited to send in comments and nominations. Each member attending the General Assembly is entitled to one vote. A copy of the AMEE Constitution is available on request.
