Call to Confer a Degree

The process to confer the degree is carried out by the Registrar, who awards the degree to students.

REQUIREMENTS

- For Mexican students, all original documents are required.
- For Foreign students:
 - Have documents Validated/Apostilled.
 - Once the documents are with the Registrar, a Technical Review will be conducted, which must be signed by the student and faculty.



STEPS

All students who have finished their 18 courses become eligible for the Call to Degree.

The Academic Coordinator will present a list to the Registrar.

Make the payment for the Call to Degree. The fee changes every year.

Students on the list will enter the Call to Degree. The Registrar usually holds 3 Call to Degree sessions each year.

According to Mexican Law, all documents will be sent to the Ministry of Education for Review.

Documents will be approved and sealed, then sent back to Anahuac University.

Documents will be printed in Spanish and translated into English.

Documents are sent to the School of Bioethics.

Students provide their address for courier shipping.

The process takes between 6-12 months to complete.

Pay the shipping fee.

There will be a Virtual Closing Ceremony.

NOTES



Once the process is completed The UNESCO Chair of Bioethics and Human Right will be sending a Certificate.

To obtain the 60 European Credits students who have the degree must contact ARPA to follow the process.
