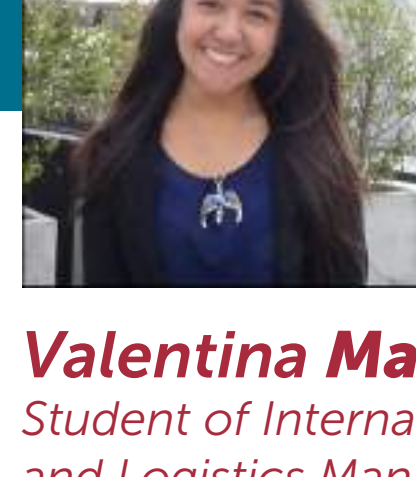
**EDUCATION:** Complementary education on Supply Chain Management & Logistics with emphasis on practical and applicable knowledge.

The UCLOG students, UCLOGERS, will develop the following competencies:



The Ability to **function in multidisciplinary teams**, made up of other students and professionals of the highest level.



The **broad education necessary to understand the impact of engineering solutions** in a **global, economic, environmental, and social context**



The ability to **identify, formulate and solve engineering problems**, being **aware** of their **impact on the environment where they are**.



An ability to **design a system, component, or process to meet desired needs within realistic constraints** such as **economic, environmental, social, political, ethical, health and safety, manufacturability, and sustainability**.

In 2008, the MIT Center for Transportation & Logistics and the logistics education and GS1 Colombia firm LOGYCA, signed a multi-year agreement to create the Center for Latin-American Logistics Innovation (CLI) as part of the MIT Global SCALE Network of supply chain research centers. Through this partnership, the MIT Global SCALE Network has developed a vibrant academic and research network throughout Latin America



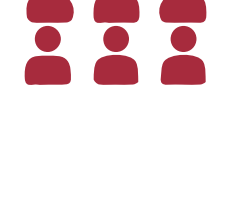
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## How do we learn in UCLOG?

The program is designed to run for 5 weeks in 2023 from **June 26th to July 28th**. It follows the principles of **Challenge-based learning**, which is a teaching strategy focused on providing students with a learning challenge based on a relevant and real problem situation, in order to develop a plausible solution. This involves:



**CLASSROOM**  
• Exploration Activities  
• Learning and research modules



**INDUSTRY-LINKED**  
• Challenge immersion and engagement  
• Collaborative problem solving  
• Coaching



**INDEPENDENT STUDIES**  
• Research work (individual and teams)



**EVALUATION**  
• Outcomes evaluation by internal and external evaluators

**Round I:** September 5th, 2022  
**10% discount**

**Round II:** December 5th, 2022  
**5% discount**

**Round III:** March 31st, 2023

Remember that sending the documents does not guarantee your admission to the program.

All applicants are evaluated under the same conditions and in case of a tie they are selected in order of arrival of documents.

## Document Instructions

- Resume or CV**  
Provide a resume that includes all your personal information and experience
- Letters of Recommendation**  
Provide the contact information for two people capable of judging your academic and/or professional potential (i.e., professor or supervisor)
- Transcripts**  
Send the corresponding transcripts of your academic experience
- Statement of Objectives**  
Please give your reasons for wanting to participate in the program. Prepare your statement of objectives and goals in whatever form clearly presents your views.
- Video Statement**  
As part of your application we need to hear from you in person. You will need webcam capability to complete your application
