Anahuac University promotes human dignity as the fundamental value that inspires its action principles while also emphasizing living with Christian values, the centrality of the individual in all its activities, and respect for human rights.

Because the university is comprised of people from all social, cultural, political, and economic conditions, it does not discriminate based on sex, age, marital status, race, nationality, religious beliefs, disability, or convictions.
